VOLUNTEER PROFILE

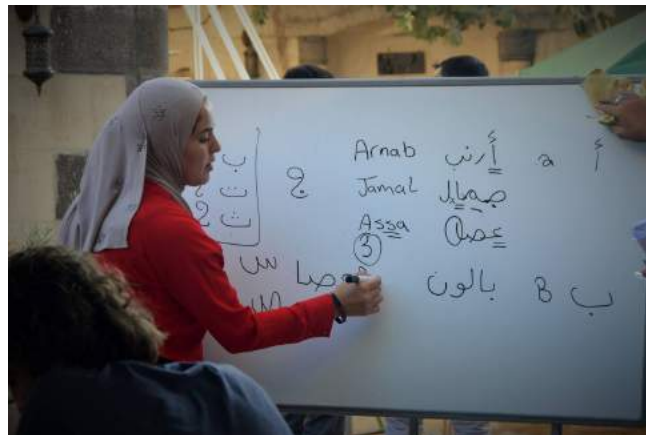
